\$411,158

FY 2026–27 total request

REQUEST ALLOCATION

\$401,158 General Fund

\$10,000 Debt Service

\$0.334824

Proposed rate is \$0.065176 higher per \$100.

At \$100,000 assessed value:

$$\$100,000 / \$100 = \$1,000 \times \$0.40$$
